The constantly changing social reality undoubtedly affects the professional work of teachers and educators, who must constantly verify their knowledge and skills in the field of teaching and upbringing. The COVID-19 pandemic has become a factor forcing a change in the way people function socially and professionally. Teachers, who had to adapt to the new reality and replace traditional methods and forms of transferring knowledge with distance learning, using new technologies, found themselves in a special situation. In order to identify resources and problems of teachers in the field of distance learning, our project team designed appropriate diagnostic tools and based on them conducted an in-depth diagnosis of the needs of teachers from Spain, Poland, Lithuania and Turkey. The results obtained during the research will be the basis for the development of appropriate applications helpful in expanding knowledge and improving skills in the use of new technologies in distance learning.

RECENT EVENTS

On 7-8 2021 a second online TPM was conducted. The meeting was dedicated to the presentation of the development of a work plan for the next period of time. During the meetings, the tools necessary for the analysis of the diagnosis and the rules for the preparation of the report on the conducted research (IO1) were agreed.
